The Meanest Mother in the World



We had the meanest mother in the whole world! While other children ate crisps for breakfast, we had to have cereal, eggs, and toast. When others had a Pepsi and a Mars Bar for lunch, we had to eat sandwiches. And you can guess our mother fixed us a dinner that was different from other children had, too. Mother insisted on knowing where we were at all times. You'd think we were convicts in a prison. She

had to know who our friends were, and what we were doing with them. She insisted that if we said we would be gone for an hour, we would be gone for an hour or less. We were ashamed to admit it, but she had the nerve to break the Child Labour Laws by making us work. We had to wash the dishes, make the beds, learn to cook, vacuum the floor, do laundry, and all sorts of cruel jobs. I think she would lie awake at night thinking of more things for us to do. She always insisted on us telling the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth. By the time we were teenagers, she could read our minds. Then, life was really tough! Mother wouldn't let our friends just sound the car horn when they drove up. They had to come up to the door so she could meet them. While everyone else could have a boyfriend or a girlfriend when they were 12 or 13, we had to wait until we were 16. Because of our mother, we missed out on lots of things other children experienced. None of us have ever been caught shoplifting, vandalising other's property, or ever arrested for any crime. It was all her fault. We never got drunk, took up smoking, stayed out all night, or a million other things, other kids did. Sundays were reserved for going to Mass, and we never missed once. We knew better than to ask to spend the night with a friend on Saturdays. Now that we have left home, we are all Godfearing, educated, honest adults. We are doing our best to be mean parents just like Mother was. I think that's what is wrong with the world today. It just doesn't have enough mean mums anymore.

- ► COACH FOR THE CHRISM MASS FROM ST PETER'S Lorna, from St Mary's, has booked a coach for this year's Chrism Mass with the new Bishop at St Margaret's Cathedral in Ayr. The Chrism Mass during the Holy Week will be on Tuesday, 26th March at 7.30pm. The coach will pick up St Bride's and St Peter's parishioners at St Peter's at 6.15pm prompt. The cost is £5 per person. - ► **SCIAF** The annual special collection for SCIAF will take place this weekend on 9th & 10th March at the Vigil and Sunday Masses. As always, many thanks for your generosity.
- ▶ STATIONS OF THE CROSS FOR VOCATIONS The Stations of the Cross, which follow the path of Christ from Pontius Pilate's praetorium to Christ's tomb are a popular devotion in our parishes during Lent. In the 16th century, this pathway was officially entitled the "Via Dolorosa" (Sorrowful Way) or simply Way of the Cross or Stations of the Cross. We can pray the Stations together this Lent every Tuesday at 9.30am in St Peter's and also every Friday at 9.30am in St Bride's.
- ► CHANA (Churches' Homeless Action North Ayrshire) During March, we hope to collect toiletries for homeless people in North Ayrshire. In particular, soap, shampoo, body wash, toothpaste, toothbrushes and disposable razors would be useful. Please leave any donations in the basket in the Porch. *Many thanks*.

A Big "Thank You" for all the Preparations and Hard Work

Lots and lots of things have been done at St Peter's in preparation for Bishop Frank's ordination. In the Church: front door bolt replaced, old floodlights replaced at the front door, ceiling of the altar Servers Sacristy repaired and painted, cupboards emptied and reorganised, drawers and cupboards in the Sacristy relabelled, choir loft reorganised and cleaned, radiators sanded down and repainted, storage room reorganised and cleaned, Church thoroughly cleaned. In the Hall: Roof leak at the front door repaired, inside ceiling repainted and repaired, Snug roof leak repaired and ceiling repainted and lights fixed, new radiator mounted on the wall of the Snug, all the roof lights in the main hall and walls replaced with LED bulbs, taps in the toilets repaired and replaced, under the roof lighting repaired and now in working order, outside ground tiles at the front entrance repaired. For all the hard work and preparations and also for the beautiful display of flowers in the sanctuary a huge, huge "thank you" to all our cleaners, workers, electricians, decorators, handymen and helpers. Also a big Thank you to all who contributed in so many ways to the liturgy and celebration: Altar Servers, Cleaners, Marshals, Readers and First Aid.

Bishop Dougan will formally be received into St Margaret's Cathedral on Sunday 10th March. The Mass will be livestreamed on YouTube (@RCGalloway) and Facebook (/GallowayDiocese). The stream will begin at 2.30 pm, with the Mass beginning at 3.00 pm.

Eucharistic Revival this Lent - The Joy of Communion

Each time we receive Jesus in the Eucharist—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity—we touch Heaven. It is this Eucharistic Glory that gives us the patience and courage we need for the sacred pilgrimage we call life. Paul modelled this joy when he was in prison. From prison he wrote more about joy than any other topic. These writings are referred to as the "Prison Epistles" and include: Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, and Philemon. During his first imprisonment, which is mentioned in Acts 28, Paul wrote Ephesians to encourage the believers in Ephesus, and to explain the nature and the purpose of the Body of Christ—the Church. His letter to the Philippians teaches that true joy comes from Jesus Christ, and emphasises the themes of Christian living: humility, personal sacrifice, and unity. Colossians teaches that Jesus is True God and True Man and the head of the Church. Philemon is a powerful teaching on Christian love and forgiveness. And throughout his writings, despite his trials and tribulations, the theme of joy shines through time and again. It is a joy fuelled by his hope for Heaven—and not just for himself. [Matthew Kelly]


