# Mustard Seeds

What if everyone who is meant to soar "like an eagle" would, finally, stop poking around on the ground? Baptism is not simply a celebration of a new life, or even an act of praying for and offering a child to God. It is, rather, the visible sign of the invisible grace of incorporation into the Mystical Body of Jesus. It changes an objective state of affairs, whether we acknowledge it or not. There is a well-known "parable" of the eagle's egg that tumbled out of the nest only to fall amidst a flock of chickens. When the eaglet was hatched, the only world he came to know was that of chickens, and hence he spent his first years pecking on the ground and never spreading his great wings. One day, I continued, a majestic eagle flew overhead and spotted his young confrere on the ground, acting like a chicken. "What's the matter with you?" he asked. "Don't you know who you are?" He then taught the eaglet how to deploy his wings and soar. So it goes on the day of our Baptism. Every baptised person is, objectively speaking, a child of God, divinised, and destined to be a great saint. But the problem is that most of those who have received this new identity promptly forget it and take on the beliefs and practices of the world. Following the prompts of television, movies, social media, pop stars, and secularist ideologues, we give ourselves over to the acquisition of wealth or power or material success or fame. These things aren't bad in themselves but considering them our highest value and running after them with all of our powers amounts to pecking on the ground like chickens. What we need is a strong community of people to remind us who we are. The Parish Community doesn't make us a child of God; Christ did that through the mediation of Baptism. But the Parish Family can teach us not to settle for being some pathetic shadow of who we are meant to be. Everything that they teach us, everything that they encourage us to do, should be directed to the great end of becoming a saint. I have sometimes wondered what this country would be like if everyone who is baptised in our country, lived up to his or her identity as a child of God. What if everyone who is meant to soar would, finally, stop poking around on the ground? It would be a true revolution.

#### THE BAPTISM OF JESUS

Our artist, Joachim Patinir, lived and worked in Antwerp. From this painting from circa 1521, we can see that he was a unique and influential forerunner of modern landscape painting. It is one of the few surviving paintings that Patinir signed. On the central vertical axis we see God the Father appearing amongst the clouds holding a globe, sending down the Holy Spirit in the form of a dove. Then we have the hand of John the Baptist directly above Jesus, who is looking straight at us. The river He is standing in opens up wide, into the world. On the left side we see Jesus appearing from the Sea of Galilee walking towards the multitude. The baby of the manger has grown into full adulthood, ready for His mission. Jesus is standing in the river where on that day His great ministry began, continuing all the way to the Cross... All four Gospels describe the start of Jesus' public life with Him receiving baptism in the Jordan from the hands of John. We can almost see the Father in our painting saying the words describe in our Gospel reading: And a voice came from heaven, 'You are my Son, the Beloved; my favour rests on you.' That is why Jesus came into the world: to love us. He descended all the way down to earth in order to search out each one of us. He is like a lover in search of his beloved... each one of us! Jesus' baptism inaugurates His mission. In the same way, our own Baptism inaugurates our mission to serve God. Speaking at a general audience in Rome, Pope Francis said: "I would like to ask each one of you here, and you can respond in your heart: how many of you remember the date of your baptism?" He said we should find out our baptismal date and celebrate it each year,

rather than just our birthdays. This would help remind us how important our baptism is and the mission we have embarked upon.




