We will be collecting only cereals and cereal bars. When you go shopping please buy an extra pack of cereal and bring it to Church. There will be a large basket at the back of the Church, and we will bring this down at the Offertory. Please be as generous as you can for our children.

#### The Synod in Galloway - Quotes from our Report

Very many participants highlighted the need to reach and connect with young people. Those young people who participated were largely consistent with their feedback. The Church is seen as admirable in its core messages of love, charity and community, but young people's understanding of Church teachings, and their experiences of parish life, have created the impression for some young people that the Church is "judgemental" and "hypocritical". Many young people stated that they find Mass, and Scripture, "boring". These statements were qualified by adding that boredom is due to a poor understanding of Mass and Scripture, e.g. "I don't understand the readings and some of the prayers so it's hard to listen for a whole Mass"; "we should make the words easier". Additionally, they state that their understanding of Church teaching mostly comes from their peers who can place real pressure on them not to attend Mass or engage with the Church, e.g. "Mass (for young people) is seen as dumb and stupid. So being a young person who goes to Mass regularly, it's embarrassing and I won't talk in front of my friends about things even when I know they've said something about the Church that I don't think is really what the Church is about".
