### The Great Prayer of the Rosary

[This month is a time] when the People of God express with particular intensity their love and devotion for the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is traditional in this month to pray the Rosary... I want to encourage everyone to rediscover the beauty of praying the Rosary... This can be done either as a group or individually; you can decide according to your own situations, making the most of both opportunities. The key to doing this is always simplicity. I am also providing a prayer to Our Lady that you can recite at the end of the Rosary, that I myself will pray... in spiritual union with all of you... Contemplating the face of Christ with the heart of Mary our Mother will make us even more united as a spiritual family... I keep all of you in my prayers, especially those suffering most greatly, and I ask you, please, to pray for me. I thank you, and with great affection I send you my blessing.

O Mary, You shine continuously on our journey as a sign of salvation and hope. We entrust ourselves to you, Health of the Sick, who, at the foot of the cross, were united with Jesus' suffering, and persevered in your faith.

"Protectress of all God's people", you know our needs, and we know that you will provide, so that, as at Cana in Galilee, joy and celebration may return after this time of trial.

Help us, Mother of Divine Love, to conform ourselves to the will of the Father and to do what Jesus tells us. For he took upon himself our suffering, and burdened himself with our sorrows to bring us, through the cross, to the joy of the Resurrection. Amen.

#### The Synod in Galloway - Quotes from our Report

"Overwhelmingly, the opportunity to participate in the Synod was seen as positive. A sense emerged that people were largely grateful for the opportunity, hopeful for the future, and eager for more such encounters to build and renew parish and diocese. Clear guidance on what the objective is and rooting the encounter in an invitation to the Holv Spirit to take the lead were also considered benefits of the encounter model... The format of the encounters was to use open questions and encourage personal reflection, in keeping with the specified purpose of the Synod "to plant dreams, draw forth prophecies and visions, allow hope to flourish, inspire trust, bind up wounds, weave together relationships, awaken a dawn of hope, learn from one another and create a bright resourcefulness that will enlighten minds, warm hearts, give strength to our hands" (PD §32)."
