# Mustard Seeds

### God's Pictures

The history of salvation is the history of God showing how much he cares. We have all experienced God's closeness at one time or another. Sally was a little girl who learned to experience it all the time. Sally walked to and from school every day. She loved skipping along the pavement, looking at the flowers, and saying "hello" to neighbours and the people along the way. One morning, the sky was cloudy and rain was forecast for later in the day. But Sally still wanted to walk to school. Her mother allowed her to but told her to take her umbrella, just in case. When school was over, Sally began her walk home. As she skipped along, the wind began to howl and raindrops started falling from the sky. Sally opened her umbrella and continued on her way. Suddenly a bolt of lightning cut through the sky, followed by the roar of thunder. Sally's mother quickly jumped into her car and drove the route to Sally's school. She was worried that Sally might be hurt by the storm, or frightened by the noise and flashing light, which was now occurring at regular intervals, several times a minute. Around the corner, Sally's mother saw her little girl walking along with her umbrella. But at each flash of lightning, Sally would stop, look up at the sky, and smile. Sally's mother watched Sally do the same thing three times: Each lightning flash caused Sally to stop walking, look up at the sky, and smile. Finally, Sally's mother called to her, "Sally, what on earth are you doing?" Sally answered, "I'm smiling. God keeps taking pictures of me." That isn't just a nice story; it's true. In the 16th century, this pathway was officially entitled the "Via Dolorosa" (Sorrowful Way) or simply Way of the Cross or Stations of the Cross. We can pray the Stations together this Lent every Tuesday at 9.30am in St Peter's and also every Friday at 9.30am in St Bride's.

#### **Episcopal Ordination of Father Frank Dougan**

On the weekend of 9th-10th March there will be two celebrations associated with the Episcopal Ordination of Bishop Elect Frank Dougan. The Mass of Ordination will take place on Saturday 9th March at 11 am in the Church of St-Peter-in-Chains, Ardrossan. This venue was chosen on account of its capacity and entry will only be possible for those who have tickets. The Ordination Mass will also be broadcast live in the parish hall of St Peter-in-Chains and anyone who does not have a ticket will be welcome to attend in the hall until it is filled. Communion from the Ordination Mass will be distributed to the people in the hall and the bishop will go to the hall to impart his blessing on the congregation near the end of the Mass. @GallowayDiocese. After the Ordination, a buffet reception will take place at St Matthew's Academy, and all are welcome. #### Who am I?

# Eucharistic Revival this Lent – What is the one thing that makes the Catholic Church unique?

We all know plenty of people who have left the Church, and even more who have simply stopped practicing the faith. But how many people do you know who have left the Catholic Church who believe in the True Presence? None I suspect. I don't know any. And herein lies the answer. Those who believe don't leave. It's the one simple beautiful truth that will change everything. There are 45,000 different denominations of Christianity in the world. What is the one thing that makes the Catholic Church unique? "It's not just one thing," some people will argue, "Many things make Catholicism unique." They are right. But what one thing differentiates Catholicism more than anything else? What is the principal differentiator between the Catholic Church and the churches on every other street corner? The Eucharist. Jesus Christ-the King of Kings, the Lord of Lords, the Alpha and the Omega-truly present-Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity—in the Eucharist. He is the difference. [from Matthew Kelly]


