#### The Martyrs of Compiègne Toe the Line

When we focus on serving Christ, instead of trying to serve two masters, our lives take on the heroic, meaningful dimension that we long for. We see this clearly in the lives of the saints. The example of the 16 Carmelite Martyrs of Compiègne is especially moving. These religious sisters lived during the French Revolution. At the very start of the Revolution, its leaders sent representatives to their convent and invited them to abandon their vocation and join the New France. But the sisters chose to continue serving Christ in prayer and penance, far from the busy and exciting world of pleasure and power. The revolutionaries couldn't tolerate such a counter-witness to their secular creed. So the convent was forcibly dispersed. The nuns were forbidden to live in community or wear a habit. So they took lay clothes and lived separately. But somehow they still managed to come together for prayer, during which they offered themselves to God as a sacrifice for peace. As a result, eventually they were arrested and imprisoned. Towards the end of the Reign of Terror, the entire community was condemned to death. They were loaded onto a cart and brought to the guillotine. On the way they sang the Veni Creator, the same ancient hymn sung whenever a young woman professes her vows in the Carmelite Order. One by one each sister mounted the gallows and laid her head on the block without any executioner having to touch her. As the sixteen martyrs sealed their love for Christ with their blood, the usually frenzied crowd of onlookers was utterly silent. The only sound to be heard was the sisters' singing the Salve Regina, a hymn to Mary. Their mortal remains were thrown in a common grave with 1300 other victims of the Revolution. Two days afterwards, however, the Reign of Terror came to an end. Those courageous women faithfully served only one Master - and the fruits of their sacrifice proved that he was the right one to serve.

#### Making a Prayer-Improvement Plan

One area where all of us can always use some renewed energy and astuteness is in our prayer life. We simply can't grow as Christians unless our prayer life is constantly growing. And yet, most of us will recognise a lot of room for improvement in this area. We all face unique challenges and opportunities in this area, so we have to work out our own formulas for growth. But two qualities are common to every healthy prayer life, so it will be helpful to keep them in mind as we make our prayer-improvement plans. First, prayer needs to be regular. We need to pray daily, to have a daily quiet time when we can speak to Christ, pray for our loved ones, reflect on the scriptures, or read some good, solid spiritual book. That means carving out the time. It doesn't have to be a lot of time - ten minutes in the morning and ten minutes at night is a good start - but it has to be consistent, and that means self-discipline. I know of one priest who goes to the cemetery to pray his Rosary, because he knows that if he doesn't, the barrage of phone calls and requests will simply crowd it out. Second, prayer needs to be sincere. We actually have to speak with Christ in our hearts. Going through the motions or just rattling off ready-made prayers is not enough. We need to find that way of praying that will allow Christ's grace to touch the core of who we are. Today, Christ is reminding us that he wants us to be wise stewards, to give him and his Kingdom our best efforts, so that he can give us the greatest reward. When he comes again in Holy Communion, let's tell him that we want the same thing.


