Mustard Seeds Christmas Football

It's Christmas Eve, 1914. The First World War is raging, and the trenches on the western front are filled with miserable men. The Germans soldiers are facing off against the British soldiers. Death, suffering, violence, and hatred reign. But then something remarkable happens. A British soldier, Private Albert Moran of the 2nd Queens Regiment, recalled how the silence of the frosty night was suddenly broken, not by artillery fire, but by a song. Some German soldiers were singing "Silent Night." Moran described how the British waited for them to finish, and then began to sing "O Come, All Ye Faithful" in English. The Germans listened, and then began to sing the same song in Latin. Private Moran said it was deeply moving to hear enemies singing the same song to Christ in different languages. Remember those words from the prophet Micah: "He will be peace." Then on Christmas day both sides declared an impromptu ceasefire, and Germans and British gather together to wish each other a Merry Christmas. Some of them



hugged each other. Some exchanged food. One British soldier even gave a haircut to a shaggy German soldier. Later that day a group organised a football game in noman's land. Men who had been at each other's throats 24 hours before were playing and laughing and wishing each other a Merry Christmas. "He will be peace." The celebration of Christ's birth was enough to bring peace to those men.

He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.
