✤ Making the Most of Holy Week

Perhaps Lent this year went well for us, a profound time of confronting weaknesses out of love for the Lord. Or maybe it went rather poorly, and in fact was kind of forgotten in all the busyness of life. Either way, there is still time to take advantage of the opportunity the Church gives us to grow closer to Christ. Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday, which unites the "royal splendour of Christ with the proclamation of his passion," says the Vatican's Directory on Popular Piety and the Liturgy (No. 138). Palms and olive branches are kept in the home as a witness to faith in Jesus Christ, the messianic King, and in his paschal victory." Lent ends officially with the beginning of the Easter Triduum at the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. Through the Washing of Feet, we remind ourselves that we are called to love our neighbour and notice their needs. There is at the end of Mass, the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, available until 8.30pm — is the best way to end Holy Thursday. The Easter fast that many begin after Holy Thursday Mass is obligatory on Good Friday. "Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of both fast and abstinence from meat. Mass isn't offered on Good Friday; but a Communion service and veneration of the cross is. When possible, Catholics take a break from work between the hours of noon and 3pm, the time Christ spent on the cross. This is also a prime time to pray privately the Stations of the Cross. Holy Saturday is a silent time of waiting. No Mass is offered, not even a Communion service like Good Friday's. It isn't an official fasting day, but many Catholics eat modestly this day as we wait to celebrate the Resurrection.



On the Saturday evening, we celebrate the Resurrection with the wonderful Easter Vigil. This is the greatest feast of the Church as we carry in the Light of Christ and dispel the darkness. Easter Sunday is the great day of victory and new beginning for all of us!

"The Light is On for You"

Our Lord says to us: "Nothing you confess could make me love you less" - come before him with trust in his mercy. Come to Confession this Lent, Saturdays 4.30pm until 5pm.

Sacrament of the Reconciliation

Why confess my sins to a priest? Why not just pray for forgiveness on my own? Because it's right there in the Bible. Jesus gave the power to release people from their sins to his Apostles, who were the first bishops and priests. When you wrong somebody, you have to seek forgiveness on their terms—when we sin, we wrong Jesus. That's why we seek healing and forgiveness on Jesus' terms. But why did Jesus make confession to a priest mandatory? It's psychologically healing. It gets you straighter to God than praying by yourself would. It roots out deadly sins. And because your sin hurts the community of the Church, you need the opportunity to confess to the priest who represents the Church. Remember: Jesus wants you to be free, to not wallow in your misery. He wants you to bask in the grace and mercy he died to give you. Confession isn't for him, it's for you. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is always a place of victory, a place where people are returning to Jesus. Has God been Number One in your life? We want to be a good person - we are not as good as we should be, and not as bad as we could be. Is God is the centre of your life? We often don't put God in the centre, and we put in on the side-lines. What is sin? Definition: Lord, I know what you want me to do, but I don't care, I want to do what I want. Definition of mortal sin: It's bad, I know it's bad, and I do it anyway.

Four places where you can start:

- 1. Find a good examination of conscience.
- 2. Pray the Litany of Humility notice what wounds we have.
- 3. Going to Jesus is own words The Beatitudes
- St Ignatius writes: "Ask the Holy Spirit to help you, go over the day when did I say yes. When did I say thank you God. When were the times where God was offering his grace and I said no. Go through those moments.

Please forgive, Lord." You will make a great confession.
